The Royal Moroccan Chess Federation (FRME) organizes the 1<sup>st</sup> FREM TT, in four 4 sections:

**A) Twomovers (#2)** Theme Kharkov-2 in no less than a three-phase two-way, the black move is a refutation of one of the phases, and no less than in the other two phases leads to different white mats.

Phase 1 - 1.X? 1 ... a !; 2nd phase - 1 ... a 2.Y #; 3rd phase - 1 ... a 2.Z #

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**B) Threemovers (#3)** Theme at least 2 variants with destruction of the white batteries in the second step.

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**C) Moremovers (#4-6)** Theme In the process of the solution a position arises where any white pieces exchange places where they were in the initial position. The thematic game with pawns will be considered weaker.

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**D) Helpmates (H#2)** Theme after the first move of the white, the threat of mate occurs. Black has no tempo move, and after his second move the mate will change. The theme must be processed in all phases. All forms of twins are possible. (Reciprocal threat and mate exchange AB - BA by example is not necessary; 4 separate elements AB - CD may be used).
